The City of La Habra is accepting applications from interested citizens wishing to serve on a City Advisory Commission(s). It is the policy of the City Council to make appointments on the basis of interest and qualification of the applicant. Applicants must be residents of La Habra. The following appointments are available:

- **PLANNING COMMISSION:** Two seats with 4-year terms expiring on March 31, 2024. The Planning Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters pertaining to planning, zoning, land use permits, and the General Plan. This Commission meets the second and fourth Monday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chamber, located at 100 East La Habra Boulevard.
- **COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMISSION:** One seat with 3-year term expiring on March 31, 2023 and one unscheduled vacancy expiring on March 31, 2022. The Community Services Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters pertaining to recreation, cultural, child development, youth and senior programs and social services. This Commission meets the second Wednesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chamber, located at 100 East La Habra Boulevard.
