Westridge Golf Club is closing, like many golf courses in California and hundreds across America. That's a loss, but La Habra will gain much more from the new neighborhood of Rancho La Habra that will replace it.

Westridge Golf Club is private property and costs as much as \$70 per person to enjoy. It has no free public open space. Included in Rancho La Habra's 86 acres of open space will be 39 acres of new public open space that will be available for free to all of La Habra, including a new 16.6-acre City Park, 4.2 miles of new public trails, a new City Community Center and much more.

Rancho La Habra will generate strong positive cash flow for the City, because the new revenues it will produce are estimated to more than double the cost of providing city services. That's money the City can use, year after year, to provide necessary city services.

Plus, local schools will receive approximately \$3.8 million in new funds for facilities from school fees generated by Rancho La Habra.



Join the Conversation

We are proud of our local quality of life in La Habra, and we want to continue providing our residents with services which make La Habra a great place to live, work, play, and raise a family. While the City has been able



to address our needs and balance the budget through cuts and delays without impacting public services, external pressures beyond the City's control, including, as happens in many cities in California, state "takeaways" and unfunded mandates, continue to place stress on La Habra's budget, potentially affecting the services our residents expect and deserve.

As part of our community-focused budget and planning process, the City recently conducted a community survey to gauge resident opinion on service priorities. Some identified by La Habrans include:

1. Maintaining firefighter, paramedic, and 9-1-1 emergency response services;
2. Maintaining gang prevention and anti-gang/anti-drug programs;
3. Improving traffic flow;
4. Protecting groundwater supplies;
5. Removing hazardous waste from the community;
6. Partnering with other North Orange County cities to reduce homelessness; and
7. Improving the ability of the City to respond quickly and effectively to natural disasters.

Residential Organics Recycling Starts in La Habra

On December 2, 2019 the City of La Habra and CR&R Environmental Services launched the City's NEW residential organics recycling program. Previously the green carts only accepted yard waste, which includes tree branches, leaves, grass clippings, weeds and other trimmings. Under the new program, these organics (green) carts will continue to accept yard waste, but can now accept food waste such as bread, fruit, meat, vegetables, dairy, cooking oil, cooking grease, and fats.

Tips for using your organics cart:

- Start with yard trimmings such as leaves, grass clippings, and/or straw at the bottom of your organics cart to prevent food scraps from being trapped.

- Alternating layers of food scraps and yard trimmings will help keep your cart cleaner.
- Keep your organics cart dry and out of sunlight to reduce odor.
- **Compostable bags are optional** and available at local retailers. *Other types of bags, such as plastic and cloth bags are not accepted.*

What Happens to the Organics Waste?

For many decades, La Habra's food waste was disposed of into the landfill system as a valueless waste item. Instead, due to La Habra's new organics program, organics waste is a valuable commodity. Organic material will be delivered to CR&R's Regional Organics Anaerobic Recovery Facility (ROAR), located in Perris, CA. The anaerobic digester (AD) facility takes the organic waste and then converts it into renewable natural gas that is then used as fuel for the trash trucks. Any excess gas that is produced is piped directly into the regional natural gas pipeline system. The residual matter left over from the anaerobic process is then used as high-quality compost.

Why the Switch?

In recent years, the California Legislature and Governor have been focused on implementing new programs designed to further reduce the amount of waste disposed in California's landfills. The latest laws require cities to develop programs to manage all organic waste to prevent it from entering the landfill system, with additional goals of reducing the amount of greenhouse gases being emitted into the atmosphere. Based on data from CalRecycle's 2014 waste characterization study, it was found that organic waste and compostable paper accounted for 41 percent of the statewide waste stream. The California Air Resources Board estimates that organic waste reduction regulations will reduce 47 to 57 million metric tons of CO2 equivalents from the State of California waste stream by the year 2030.

How Common is Organics Recycling in Other Areas?

Organic waste collection programs (including food waste) have been prevalent in Europe since at least the 1980s. In North America, organics collection and composting programs started to become more widespread only in the

last few decades. Toronto, Canada, claims to be first major North American city to roll out a major residential 'Green Bin' (Organics) Program in 2002. San Francisco started its business and residential organics recycling program in 2009. New York City started its food waste program in 2013. Seattle started their composting program in 2015, followed by Boise, Idaho which started a similar program in 2017.

New! Vote Centers & Drop Boxes

Beginning this year, vote centers will be open for voting and registration for up to 10 days prior to election day, allowing voters the opportunity to cast their ballot at any vote center throughout Orange County. Prior to the election, all voters will receive a vote-by-mail ballot that can be mailed back or dropped off at any Vote Center or Ballot Drop Box location. This new election model will allow voters more options to vote early and on Election Day. For additional information, please visit the Orange County Registrar of Voters website at www.ocvote.com.

WAYS TO VOTE: Mail (no stamp required), Vote-By-Mail Ballot Drop Box Location (108 drop boxes countywide), or at a Vote Center (188 vote centers countywide).

WHEN TO VOTE: Vote at ANY Vote Center location countywide beginning 10 days before Election Day, including two weekends before Election Day. Election drop-off boxes are open for vote-by-

mail ballots, 29 days before Election Day, at the following La Habra locations:

VOTE CENTERS — ONE-STOP LOCATIONS: Unlike traditional polling locations, vote centers will allow voters to not only vote, but to solve voter registration issues, register to vote, obtain a replacement ballot, and get general assistance for up to 10 days prior to and on Election Day. Electronic check-in is more secure and speeds up the process. La Habra vote centers are located at:

LA HABRA'S DROUGHT TOLERANT PLANT OF THE QUARTER:

***Western Redbud*
(*Cercis occidentalis*)**

Cercis occidentalis, also known by the common name Western Redbud, is a small deciduous tree found in the foothills and mountains of California. It has showy bright pink flowers that grow in clusters all over the tree. The blooming period is during the springtime months; at higher elevations, the leaves are known to change to a gold or red color as the weather cools, and it does go dormant in the winter.

Native Californians used the twigs of the Western Redbud to weave baskets, and even pruned the shrub to encourage growth of new twigs, as well as using the bark to color the

finished baskets. The tree also supports many wildlife species, such as bees, birds, and 11 different species of butterflies and moths.

The Western Redbud requires little maintenance, responds well to occasional pruning and is resistant to Oak root fungus. It is fairly adaptable, but grows best in full sun to part shade. Once established, it will naturalize, but might need watering one to two times a month during the peak of summer. It can grow over 8-20 feet tall with a spread of over ten feet wide at maturity and generally grows in chaparral and woodland areas around foothill locations below altitudes of 4,500 feet and is hardy down to temperatures of 15 degrees Fahrenheit. It is adaptable to many different types of soils, from fast draining to slow draining soils.

Western Redbud can be paired with other companion species such as Bush Anemone (*Carpenteria californica*), Silktassel Bush (*Garrya elliptica*), Deer Grass (*Muhlenberia rigens*), Mock Orange (*Philadelphus lewisii*), Oaks (*Quercus* species), Elderberry (*Sambucus nigra*), Sages (*Salvia* species), and Ceanothus species.

Spring/Summer Water Restrictions Update

As of February 5, 2020, the United States Drought Monitor continues to rate Orange County and La Habra as not being in a state of drought (out of six levels with 5 being the highest and 0 meaning no drought), a major improvement from a year ago, when we still were in moderate drought conditions. The National Weather Service's Climate Prediction Center still forecasts no drought conditions for Southern California, however Northern California is likely to develop drought conditions in the coming months. La Habra residents need to continue to conserve as much as possible, as warmer than normal temperatures and less than normal rainfall is expected for the rest of the year. La Habra will continue to stay at a Stage 1 water supply shortage level.

Starting on April 1, 2020, the City of La Habra's Water Supply Shortage Program will switch back to its normal schedule. From April 2020 through October 2020, irrigation

will be limited to no more than two days per week. Odd numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Mondays, Wednesdays, or Fridays. Even numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Tuesdays, Thursdays, or Saturdays. The two-day-a-week restrictions do not apply to landscape irrigation zones that exclusively use very low flow drip type irrigation systems when no emitter produces more than two gallons of water per hour. It also does not apply to watering or irrigating by use of a hand-held bucket or similar container, a hand-held hose equipped with a positive self-closing water shut-off nozzle or device, or for very short periods of time for the express purpose of adjusting or repairing an irrigation system. Other permanent restrictions are as follows:

- Watering lawns is prohibited between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm.
- Water runoff is prohibited.
- Washing down hard surfaces (sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, walkways, etc.) is prohibited.
- Leaks or malfunctions must be repaired promptly upon discovery or within 48 hours of notification by the City.
- Washing any vehicle with water is prohibited unless an automatic shut off nozzle is used, or the vehicle is

Yard Sales: Questions & Answers

Who may hold a yard sale?

Residents living within single-family residential zones in the City may conduct a yard, garage, estate and/or moving sale from their property. A yard sale is an event where items of personal property owned, used or maintained by the occupants of the property are sold. A rummage sale by a licensed non-profit organization is not included in this category.

What items can be sold?

All items sold at a yard sale must be used goods, wares or merchandise of a household of a personal nature, from that household, and not acquired elsewhere for resale.

When may I have a yard sale?

Yard sales may only be conducted on the second full weekend of every month from 8 am to 5 pm, with a maximum of four (4) yard sales per calendar year. A yard sale may not be held for more than three (3) consecutive weekend days (Friday-Sunday). The Code Enforcement Division Manager may approve a yard sale on an alternate weekend under special circumstances. An additional form will be required. This year's dates are:

- March 6, 7, 8
- April 3, 4, 5
- May 1, 2, 3
- June 5, 6, 7
- July 3, 4, 5
- August 7, 8, 9
- September 4, 5, 6
- November 6, 7, 8
- October 2, 3, 4
- December 4, 5, 6

Where are yard sales allowed?

Yard sales may be conducted on private property. They are prohibited on the public right-of-way, including sidewalks, parkways, streets or alleys. Yard sales shall only be conducted on properties permitted for residential use.

How can I advertise?

Yards sale advertising signs may not be posted on telephone poles, streetlights, traffic signs, or any other structure in the public right-of-way. Signs may be posted on private property with the written permission of the owner. Signs may be posted two days prior to the event and shall be removed at the termination of the sale.

and Sweet Little Hand Signs*

Grace Allen was born in Watts, then adopted and raised in Whittier, where she attended local schools. She was interested in art from an early age, taking classes through the local community center since she was seven years old, then continuing on to high school art classes. She studied psychology and human relations at Fullerton College, but left to raise her three children, ages seven, four and almost two years old. She has been involved in a variety of types of art, and at first wasn't that interested in hand lettering, but she realized how popular it is now. That, coupled with the very positive response she receives when she fills orders, caused her to fall in love with it. She is quick to point out the difference between hand lettering and calligraphy; the latter is always done with a fountain pen, whereas lettering can be done using other tools, which range from paint pens to woodburning tools. She works in different media, lettering on wood or paper, to name two. Lettering styles include block letters, cursive, and graffiti, to name a few. Students practice tracing different styles and then choose a word to practice on, producing projects to take home. She has taught home workshops and one-on-one classes, in addition to teaching at the Community Center.

Grace also will be teaching a baby sign language class. Because of growing up in a family with in which her grandparents and other family members were deaf, and because she was born with a cleft palate and didn't speak until she was older, American Sign Language was her first language. In fact, she says she is a 4th generation ASL speaker!


