NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of La Habra will hold a Public Hearing to review and approve a substantial amendment to the FY 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan. The substantial amendment will include funding for security improvement project at the skatepark located at La Bonita Park for FY 20-21.

A substantial amendment was approved at a Public Hearing on March 16, 2020 that canceled FY 19-20 programs and left a balance in the amount of \$76,612.

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$51,000 will be allocated to the FY 20-21 La Bonita Skatepark Security Improvement Project located at La Bonita Park. The remaining balance in the amount of \$25,612 will be carryover funds for FY 20-21.

Staff is recommending City Council approve the following FY 20-21 program:

(FY 20-21) La Bonita Skatepark Security Improvement Project in the amount of \$51,000.

The public is invited to provide written comment on the proposed substantial amendment during the 30-day public review period beginning Saturday, June 20 and continuing through Monday, July 20th at 4:30 p.m. All written comments must be provided to the Housing Division located at City Hall, 110 E. A draft of the substantial amendment will be available for review on the City's website at www.lahabraca.gov, in person during regular business hours at Community Development located at 110 E. La Habra Blvd., La Habra, CA 90631, and during regular hours at the La Habra Community Center located at 101 W. La Habra Blvd., La Habra, CA 90631.

The public is also invited to attend and provide feedback at the Public Hearing before City Council on Monday, July 20, 2020 at 6:30 pm in the City Council Chambers located at W. 100 E. La Habra Blvd., La Habra, CA 90631.
