The City of La Habra will be accepting applications on a continuous basis for its COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance Program.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Online application and guidelines are available on the City's website, in person at Community Development Department (City Hall) and/or Community Center located at 101 W. La Habra Blvd.

Applications will continue to be accepted via mail or hand delivery. Hand delivered applications can be submitted Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm in a sealed envelope to:

The Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) will provide emergency rental assistance grants to income-eligible individuals and families economically impacted during the COVID-19 pandemic through job loss, furlough or reduction in hours or pay, residing in the City of La Habra. Emergency grants are rental payments made to landlord/property management company on behalf of an income-eligible applicant, for a maximum period of 3 consecutive months, to maintain housing and/or to reduce rental delinquency in arrears as a result of the economic downturn during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Being unemployed due to COVID-19 does not automatically qualify you for assistance. Qualification is based on the total income of all members of the household.

At a minimum, qualified applicants must meet the following:
