What is a Community Build?

Community Builds are volunteer-driven initiatives designed to improve or enhance a program or property owned or supported by the City.

Why offer a Community Build Program?

We have learned that when a community engages in a common goal, a number of outcomes occur: first, a sense of accomplishment and good will toward the project; second, a sense of ownership and contribution for the community; and third, the reduction of vandalism at the site.

How does one get involved?

The only requirement to participate is the willingness to give of oneself to an effort to enhance a physical site or program supported or owned by the City.



How many Community Build Projects a year do you host?

There is no set number. Community Build is a designation given so that volunteers will know that the project serves the greater good of the community.

How do you pay for a Community Build Project?

Community Builds are financially supported by outside sources such as grants, donations, or fundraisers that are driven by people.
