





# City News

## Civic Center Nearing Completion

The new La Habra Civic Center — located at the southeast corner of La Habra Boulevard and Euclid Street and future home to La Habra City Hall — is nearing completion. The \$20 million project represents a public-private partnership between the City of La Habra and City Ventures, a for-profit residential housing developer. City Ventures acquired the new Civic Center location and then sold it to the City. As part of that transaction, the City agreed to sell to City Ventures the property upon which the existing City Hall is located. Once the new Civic Center is completed and municipal operations have been relocated, City Ventures will raze the “old” City Hall and build 71 market rate homes.

The new Civic Center is not a “ground-up” construction, but rather an adaptive reuse of three buildings that were already on site. The former bank building right at the corner will become the new Council Chamber. The two office buildings to the east were joined by a roof structure and will house several City departments, including Administration, City Clerk, Community Development, Engineering, Finance,

and Human Resources. In addition, the United States Postal Office currently located at 200 North Euclid Street will lease space in the Civic Center. The new Civic Center is roughly twice the size of old City Hall, and includes ample meeting space that can also be used by community organizations.

Also part of the project, last spring the City renovated Veterans Hall on Orange Street, breathing new life into a well-used asset. And there is an expansion now underway at the La Habra Community Center that will add even more

meeting space for community events. The La Habra Police Department will remain where it is, as will the La Habra Branch of the Orange County Public Library and the La Habra Historical Museum.

## Mosquito-Borne Virus Updates

The City of La Habra was notified by the OC Mosquito and Vector Control District that they have detected the presence of the invasive *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, which is capable of transmitting Zika virus, chikungunya, Dengue, yellow fever, and dog heartworm. While the mosquito itself can transmit the Zika virus, the mosquito must first acquire the virus from an infected person. At this time, there are no known travel-associated human cases of Zika in La Habra.

In addition, a number of months ago, the City was advised by OC Vector that La Habra has had "positive" non-human lab tests for West Nile Virus, also transmitted by mosquitos. Since WNV is a virus, there is no "cure" and like any other virus, it must run its course once contracted. Ordinarily, a healthy person's immune system will resist and help the person get better, however it can lead to meningitis or encephalitis. Young children and the elderly are of particular concern because of their underdeveloped/compromised immune systems).

Our Caring Community is encouraged to continue to take precautions to avoid being bit by mosquitoes. The following information is presented by the Orange County Mosquito and Vector Control District:

### HOW TO PROTECT YOUR FAMILY & COMMUNITY

- Report black-and-white daytime-biting mosquitos, to **714-971-2421** or **949-654-2421**. You can also submit an online service request at <http://www.ocvector.org/InvasiveMosquitoes.html>.
- This FREE service includes inspection and treatment.
- Remove or drill holes in the bottom of all plant pots, saucers, barrels, bins, and old tires.
- Do not keep water in buckets or root plant cuttings in water. Sharing plant cuttings can spread mosquito eggs.
- Cover trash cans, toys and recycle bins, and keep unneeded items out of the rain.
- Ensure rain barrels are properly sealed. Thousands of eggs can be laid inside rain barrels.
- Wear insect repellent containing DEET®, Picaridin, IR 3535, or oil of lemon eucalyptus.

## La Habra Water Restrictions Update

As of October 31, 2016, the U.S. Drought Monitor still rates Northern Orange County and La Habra as in a state of exceptional drought, which is the highest drought level. The National Weather Service's Climate Prediction Center still forecasts a persisting drought for much of California with no improvement. It is imperative that La Habra residents continue to conserve as much as possible. Starting on November 1, 2016, the City of La Habra's Water Supply Shortage Program will switch to its winter schedule. From November 2016 through March 2017, irrigation will be limited to no more than 1 day per week. Odd numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Tuesdays, and even numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Thursdays. The one day a week restrictions do not apply to landscape irrigation zones that exclusively use very low flow drip type irrigation systems when no emitter produces more than two gallons of water per hour. This provision also does not apply to watering or irrigating by use of a hand-held bucket or similar container, a hand-held hose equipped with a positive self-closing water shut-off nozzle or device, or for very short periods of time for the express purpose of adjusting or repairing an irrigation system. Other permanent restrictions are as follows:

- Watering lawns is prohibited between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm.
- Water runoff is prohibited.
- Washing down hard surfaces (sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, walkways, etc.) is prohibited.
- Repair leaks or malfunctions promptly upon discovery or within 48 hours of notification by the City.
- Washing any vehicle with water is prohibited unless an automatic shut off nozzle is used or the vehicle is taken to a commercial car washing facility that uses a recirculating system.
- Water no more than 15 minutes per station (valve) per day.

## FireMed Saves You Money While Saving Lives

Have you ever wondered who will pay the bill for services provided by the paramedics when 911 is called? The answer is you. The City of La

Habra, like many other cities, passes some of the cost of providing emergency medical services on to the people who use them. La Habra's FireMed program is a voluntary subscription program, which supplements your insurance coverage and helps control pre-hospital medical costs for the low cost of \$48 annually. Any resident within the City of La Habra may join the program.

The subscription membership covers all family members with permanent residence at your address and protects insured members from any out-of-pocket expenses related to paramedic treatment and emergency 911 ambulance transportation for situations that occur in the City of La Habra. If you have insurance, your insurance will be billed for the services rendered, but if your insurance denies any part of the ambulance

transportation bill, you will not be responsible for the unpaid balance. If you are not a member, the usual fees for services rendered will be billed to the person receiving the services.

## Celebrating Success & What's New in La Habra

### Museum Gifted with Hand Carved Train

The Children's Museum at La Habra received a hand carved wooden train sculpture from local restaurant Black Bear Diner. The train was carved by Ray Schulz, who also has carved more than 300 bear sculptures that decorate the exterior of all Black Bear Diner restaurants. The train, which weighs 1.5 tons and is large enough for kids to climb in the engine and for a family to sit on the bench that makes up the train behind the engine, was installed in front of the museum and serves as a reminder that The Children's Museum building was once a train depot.

### National Drug Take Back Event Nets Big Results

On Saturday, October 22nd, La Habra was once again one of the drop-off sites for National Prescription Drug Take Back Day. The purpose of this event is to keep the community free of expired, unused or unwanted prescription medications that can often be stolen or abused by others, or disposed of in a way that pollutes the environment. From 10 am until 2 pm, residents could do so, with anonymity. At the end of the event, a total of 17 boxes containing 266 pounds of drugs were collected.

### Red Ribbon Contest Inspires Art & Writing

Each year, the City holds its week-long Red Ribbon event to raise awareness of the dangers of drug use. This year's theme was "YOLO (You Only Live Once) Be Drug Free." Local elementary schools were invited to submit artwork created by individual classrooms based on the theme, and students

# Holiday Reminders from the La Habra Police Department

## Lock It, Hide It, Keep It

As the holidays approach, the La Habra Police Department would like to remind residents, and those who frequent the La Habra community, to be even more mindful of the need to properly secure their vehicles and store valuables out of sight in their cars. The department's "Lock It, Hide It, Keep It" campaign will see officers patrolling parking lots, shopping centers, and neighborhoods, not only in their police cars, but on bicycles as well.

"A vehicle with an unlocked door or an open window is an easy target, not only during the holidays, but any time of year," said Police Chief Jerry Price. "It takes less than 30 seconds for a thief to steal a phone, laptop, tablet, or wallet from a car. We want to remind drivers to remove their valuables or at least keep them out of sight."

"Our primary objective is to create awareness," Price said. "This type of crime can be easily prevented if we all take 20 seconds to secure our vehicles."

## Vacation Checks

Going on vacation? Concerned about leaving your house unattended? Then you may be interested in the free residential security checks provided by the La Habra Police Department.

This service is staffed by uniformed police department volunteers who will come out, in a marked city vehicle, to check on your residence. They will check to make sure windows and doors are locked and undamaged while you were away. If, by chance, a burglary does occur at your residence while you're gone, the individual that you specify as your emergency contact will be notified.

This service is intended to provide peace of mind for those that need to be away from their home for an extended period of time. However, please be aware that house checks are not conducted on homes that are occupied for any length of time during the homeowner's absence, and also will not be available for homes that are vacant and up for sale or rent.

Vacation check request forms can be downloaded from the city's website, [www.lahabraca.gov](http://www.lahabraca.gov), or picked up at the police station. Once completed, they should be dropped off at the front counter of the La Habra Police Department, which is located at 150 N. Euclid St., La Habra.

# Christmas Tree Pickup Program & Other Holiday Reminders

## Holiday Used Cooking Oil Collection

The City of La Habra's annual Used Cooking Oil Collection Program, which began on November 1, 2016, continues through January 31, 2017. The program offers residents a location to safely dispose of their holiday cooking oil, which should never be disposed of down the drain or in the trash. This program is offered to La Habra residents by appointment only. Please contact the Public Works Department at **562-383-4170** to make an appointment.

## Christmas Tree Recycling

The City's waste hauler, CR&R Incorporated, will collect and recycle Christmas trees for the first three weeks following Christmas on your regular collection day. Trees taller than

six feet must be cut in half. Please remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands. Place the tree at the curb. Flocked trees will be collected, but cannot be recycled. Trees being disposed of after the three week period must be cut into small pieces and recycled as regular green waste during the regular pick up.

## Holiday Trash Collection — No Schedule Change

As you may know, trash collection in La Habra is usually delayed during the week following Christmas Day and New Year's Day. This year, however, has both holidays falling on a Sunday. As a result, there will be no delay of service at all, and all trash will be serviced on your regularly scheduled pickup day.

## Holiday Street Sweeping Schedule — No Schedule Change

Since Christmas and New Year's Day both fall on a Sunday this year, street sweeping services will not be delayed, and instead will continue on their normal schedule all week long. Parking enforcement for street sweeping will not be delayed and will also continue on its normal schedule.

## Overnight Parking During the Holiday Season

The City of La Habra will suspend enforcement of the overnight parking ordinance during the holiday season. Enforcement of the parking ordinance will not occur from Monday, Nov 21, 2016, 12:00 am through Sunday, Jan 1, 2017. Enforcement will resume Monday, January 2, 2017 at 12:00 am.

## *Rosa californica 'Plena', California Wild Rose*

The California Wild Rose (*Rosa californica*) is a mounding semi-deciduous shrub that is native to California. It has fresh green leaves, pink flowers and is very fragrant. The plant has a long blooming season from spring through summer. Its flowers attract many pollinator species such as butterflies, and songbirds have been known to nest in its dense foliage. It is a very adaptable plant and can grow in full sun to full shade in a wide variety of elevations below 6000 feet. Once established it can survive on rainfall two to four times a month in the summer months. The Wild Rose can grow to 3.5 feet tall with a spread of 5 feet wide at maturity and can tolerate temperatures down to 15 degrees Fahrenheit. The plant will grow in a wide range of soil types and can do quite well in heavy soils that are hard on most native plants. This would make it an excellent choice for homes in La Habra, due to the region's notorious clay soil.



## Instructor Profiles

### Nancy McNabb

*Jacki's Aerobic Dance*

Jacki's Aerobic Dance was founded 40 years ago by Jacki Sorenson, who had a long history of involvement with physical fitness, including appearing on Jack La Lanne's television show, and serving on the President's Council on Physical Fitness. It's a progressive class specifically choreographed for non-dancers, with four new choreographed sessions introduced each year, all set to a variety of popular musical styles including the Hot 100, adult contemporary, Latin, country, rock and hip hop. All of the moves and combinations in the dances introduced are evaluated for safety before being taught, and students are taught how to check for their appropriate heart rate during the class. Instructor Nancy McNabb has been participating in Jacki's Aerobic Dance classes for 35 years, and teaching them for 30 years. She spent many years in the nursing profession, after completing her BSN at Chicago Medical Center and her MSN at the University of North Carolina. When her doctor husband's dream to work at UCLA Medical Center came true, they relocated to Southern California. She decided to join a fitness dance class when her son was a year old, either Jazzercise or Jacki's Aerobic Dance, both of which were offered at her local community center in Laguna Niguel. The latter offered babysitting during the class, making it an easy choice. She and her family moved to La Habra Heights in 1986, and Nancy began teaching her classes in La Habra through the City and at local dance studios. Not only does she have students who have been with her since then, but she also has students who were in the class when she took it over from the previous instructor. Always eager to welcome new students into the class, she says that participants can choose to work at different levels of the cardio portion to accommodate their level of fitness and familiarity with the program, and that it usually takes participating in one session for new students to master the steps and the cues.

Jump Start Sports was founded in Hudson, Ohio in 2002, by Rick Hart, who was working in advertising, but not finding it a fulfilling career. His children were enrolled in sports at the time, and he found his passion was attending their games, so he decided to found a company that would offer youth sports. Six years ago, the company began a major expansion and now has programs in Columbus, Philadelphia and Atlanta, to name a few cities. Jump Start offers an all-inclusive program that provides instructors and equipment for the sports that they offer. All of its instructors not only must have previous experience in the field of education or working with kids in other capacities, but once hired, they receive additional training by working with an experienced program leader, as well as receiving training via videos and written material. What sets Jump Start apart from other youth sports program is the fact that it emphasizes the recreational aspect of participating and sportsmanship, rather than the competitive aspect. "Our goal is to make every child feel comfortable playing the sport being taught and to enjoy leading a more active lifestyle," says class leader and instructor trainer Amanda Slutsky. "No child has to worry about having a place on a team or being picked last." Each class or league begins its meeting with instruction on the sport being played and ends with a scrimmage, where the emphasis isn't on who won, but how well everyone played and how much fun it was. Jump Start will be offering classes in soccer, basketball and volleyball, as well as a youth volleyball league, on Saturday mornings and afternoons.
