Two Hospitalized Following Traffic Collision

La Habra, CA – On Wednesday, May 3, 2017 at approximately 3:00 a.m., La Habra police officers and Los Angeles County Fire Department personnel were dispatched to the intersection of Beach Boulevard and Imperial Highway regarding a traffic collision that had just occurred at that location. When officers arrived, they found a 2002 silver Toyota Camry, a 2004 red Toyota Solara still in the roadway and a third vehicle, a 2008 black Dodge Charger, a short distance away. Both the driver of the Camry, a male adult in his late 20's and the driver of the Solara, a female adult in her late 20's, were injured and required immediate medical attention. They were both transported to an area trauma center for further treatment. The driver of the Charger, an adult female, was uninjured.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears that the driver of the Camry was traveling southbound on Beach Blvd. when he entered the intersection. The driver of the Solara was traveling east bound on Imperial Highway and the driver of the Charger was traveling westbound on Imperial Highway. While the cause of the collision is still under investigation, it does appear that alcohol was a contributing factor.

The driver of the Camry remains hospitalized in critical condition while the injuries to the driver of Solara, while significant, do not appear to be life-threatening.
