Keynote Speaker Captain Dean Capelletti



Dean Capelletti began his career with the La Habra Police Department in 2002, and within the first couple of years of service, he showed his willingness to volunteer for additional responsibilities by joining the North County SWAT Team, Ceremonial Detail, and helping with the K9 Unit as an agitator. In 2006, Dean was transferred from Patrol to the General Investigations Unit, where he was first assigned to Auto Theft, quickly moving on to Sex Crimes and Child Abuse, and later adding Homicide and Cold Cases. The Sex Crimes and Child Abuse caseload was one of Dean's most meaningful assignments, as he worked tirelessly to find justice for the victims in these cases. During his tenure in General Investigations, Dean became involved with the Orange County Juvenile Sex Offender Management Team, where he was a key member in developing products and programs to assist law enforcement in better addressing sex crimes cases that involved a juvenile suspect. Dean also became certified as a Composite Artist, and his composite drawings have been instrumental in helping solve a number of cases.

Dean was promoted to Sergeant in 2010, Lieutenant in 2013, and Captain in 2017. Over that span of time, Dean has had the privilege of working several assignments such as the Professional Standards Bureau, Investigations Bureau Commander, and SWAT Team Commander, as well as numerous auxiliary assignments and responsibilities. Dean has always enjoyed being a part of the La Habra community and has shown this by being a part of the first Spanish Citizens' Academy, Special Olympics Torch Run, Meet A SWAT Officer event, and the police department's annual open house.

Dean is married with two children. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Organizational Leadership and a Master's Degree in Public Administration.
