1. DULY NOTICED PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER A REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION 23-02 TO AMEND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 98-71 FOR THE OPERATION OF A WATER DISPENSING KIOSK (OUTDOOR VENDING MACHINE) AT 1581 WEST WHITTIER BOULEVARD, #1A

Moved by Commissioner Mahecha and seconded by Vice Chair Surich, Approving Resolution No. 23-14 Entitled: A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LA HABRA, CALIFORNIA, MAKING THE REQUIRED FINDINGS AND APPROVING MODIFICATION 23-02 TO AMEND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 98-71 FOR THE OPERATION OF A WATER DISPENSING KIOSK (OUTDOOR VENDING MACHINE) LOCATED AT 1581 WEST WHITTIER BOULEVARD, #1A, AS PER THE APPROVED PLANS AND SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS, AND MAKING THE DETERMINATION THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO SECTION 15302(B), CLASS 2: "REPLACEMENT OR RECONSTRUCTION" OF THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT GUIDELINES.

Chair Rojas thanked the Commissioners for their input and said although the role sounds fun, but she would not have time to serve as the representative. She said she was also in agreement to nominate

Vice Chair Surich for the position and questioned whether it was necessary for a Commissioner to second the motion. Planning Manager Lui replied that it was a procedural recommendation only. Based on a straw poll vote, Vice Chair Surich was selected to serve on the Centennial Celebration Ad Hoc Committee.
