Notice is hereby given that the City of La Habra Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the following item:

CONSIDERATION OF A REQUEST FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 20-22 FOR AN ABC TYPE 47 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE IN CONJUNCTION WITH A RESTAURANT AT 1299 SOUTH HARBOR BOULEVARD.
