Notice is hereby given that the City of La Habra Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the following items:

- 1. Consideration of a request for Special Event Permit 22-01 to conduct a Large Special Event at 1641-1721 West Imperial Highway.
 - This project was reviewed pursuant to the guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to Section 15304, Class 4: "Minor Alterations to Land" subsection (e) Minor temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment. This section applies to carnivals, sales of Christmas trees etc.
- 2. Consideration of a request for Conditional Use Permit 22-01 for the expansion of a restaurant (Ruby Reds BBQ) and Modification 22-01 to modify Conditional Use Permit 20-14 for an ABC Type 41 On-Sale Beer and Wine License at 1841 West Imperial Highway, Suites A and B.

This project was reviewed pursuant to the guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to Section 15301, Class 1: "Existing Facilities" of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines.

The public hearing will be held on Monday, February 28, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers located at 100 East La Habra Boulevard, La Habra, California 90631.
